
#### Elena

Elena has big-time heritage, and she's a looker too, with eight billowing sails and a mainmast reaching up to 47m. Built using the original drawings of revolutionary naval architect Nathanael Greene Herreshoff, this 55m racing schooner is a replica of a 1911 boat that participated in the 1928 King's Cup transatlantic race.

**The cabins** New England chic, with plenty of mahogany panelling. There's an owner's stateroom and four more cabins, each named after a Herreshoff schooner.

The toys Two tenders, including a gorgeous Wally, plus kayaks, and kitesurf/waterski/fishing gear. Ideal shipmate George Clooney. In shorts. Set sail for Amalfi.

#### Christina O

The most famous of old-school yachts (see page tkt), *Christina O* oozes Fifties Hollywood glamour. Former owner Aristotle Onassis wined and dined EVERYONE on her decks: Frank Sinatra, Marilyn Monroe, Greta Garbo, Liz Taylor, Jackie Kennedy (who soon became Jackie O...). She's only improved with age, and along with vast staterooms has a Six Senses spa and a beautiful mosaic-tiled pool that transforms into a dancefloor for nighttime frolics. And the bar stools are said to be upholstered with sperm-whale foreskin – which is just the thing to drop into a conversational lull.

**The cabins** More than most: 17 doubles in total. The Onassis Suite has a library, a fireplace and a Renoir, *naturellement*.

**The toys** Two classic wooden launches, as well as Zodiacs, an inflatable swim platform and sea toys.


Silver Angel
