

**The lowdown** This 43m gentlemen's cruiser manages to pull off a stately feel that's also ever so French. Following a complete overhaul of the navigational system, she manoeuvres easy as pie into the smallest of harbours. The yacht has two rotating captains; both are keen fishermen and are on hand to help you haul in a catch.

USP One of the owners has a vineyard, so there's a vast cellar on board and the chief steward will happily conduct wine tastings for guests.

Where to anchor St Barth's (almost more French than France), and then down to Los Roques, Venezuela, for some of the world's best bonefishing.
