The long haul

Spending weeks or even months at sea is becoming increasingly popular, so charterers need a yacht that's up to the task. These yachts have some of the most scene-stealing master suites and owner's areas.

▶ AHPO

The expansive owner's area is just one of the outstanding features of the 377.7-ft *Ahpo*. The split-level deck includes a large owner's suite and two twin suites for family, with access to a central lobby that leads to an informal salon and sweeping aft deck with alfresco dining for up to 22 guests and two large lounging areas. With fitness and wellness at the heart of the yacht, the owner's duplex also includes a fully-equipped gymnasium.

▶ ANJELIF

Making her debut on the charter market in winter 2024 in the Caribbean, the brand-new 163.9-ft *Anjelif* features owner's quarters with a large master suite with a Jacuzzi, hammam and infrared sauna. Other features in this private area include a large balcony, massage room, office and gymnasium.

▼ AMORE

The 121-ft *Amore* shows that these private owner's areas are not restricted to the larger yachts. The main deck houses the master suite, with a further full-beam master suite on the bridge deck with sliding doors that open to the aft deck. When tenders and toys are deployed, the aft deck transforms into a private deck, offering even more space and privacy than the main deck master.
